## CALIFORNIA MATHEMATICS COUNCIL ARTICLES OF AFFILIATION

#### I. INTRODUCTORY FACTS

- 1. The purposes of affiliation are:
  - to foster cooperation among regional organizations, other organized groups of mathematics educators, and the California Mathematics Council;
  - to promote and support the improvement of mathematics instruction;
  - to encourage formation and growth of local mathematics organizations so as to have a complete network of statewide representation.
- 2. The CMC leadership views affiliation as a means of harnessing the potential force of the coordinated mathematics educators of California to bring their concerns to the attention and consideration of educational and political bodies.
- 3. Along with the elected officers, it is the affiliate representatives that constitute the Section Board of Directors.

# II. STRUCTURE OF AFFILIATION

- 1. The State CMC is the affiliating agency for regional organizations.
- 2. A regional affiliate will be associated with the respective CMC Section as determined by the CMC State Board. Other affiliates will associate with a CMC Section as determined by the CMC State Board.
- 3. The CMC Board will aid in establishing affiliate boundaries.
- 4. The CMC Board authorizes all working arrangements to be handled through the respective CMC Section.
- 5. Affiliation with CMC does not infringe upon the right to affiliate with NCTM, MAA, or other such organizations.

## III. CMC RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1. CMC State will yearly review and renew affiliation.
- 2. CMC State will provide mailing labels and lists.
- 3. CMC State will provide the use of CMC membership forms to affiliates.

- 4. CMC State and the Sections will review, coordinate, and forward regional recommendations to NCTM and the State Legislature, as appropriate.
- 5. CMC State and the Sections will publicize local efforts and activities.
- 6. CMC State and the Sections will publish the names and addresses of officers and editors from affiliated groups.
- 7. CMC State and the Sections will support affiliate groups in their efforts to improve mathematics education in their regions.
- 8. Each Section will designate a person to coordinate services for affiliated groups and for non-affiliated groups and regions.
- 9. Each Section may appoint a representative to the Section Board from a non-affiliated group or geographic region.
- 10. Sections will assist in affiliate activities by providing speaker referrals, exhibitor lists, financial aid and executive leadership, as needed.
- 11. Each Section may provide additional services to its affiliates as determined by the Section Board.

# IV. AFFILIATED GROUP RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Each group requesting affiliation will initially affiliate by filing a list of members and officers and include amount of dues and a statement of purpose or intent.
- 2. Each affiliate will renew affiliation yearly by sending a list of current officers, a written report of the previous year's activities, current dues structure, and terms of office to CMC as of January 1, each year.
- 3. Each affiliate will send a representative to all Board of Directors meetings of the appropriate CMC section.
- 4. Each affiliate will provide copies of newsletters/journals to State and Section Presidents, ComMuniCator editor, and other CMC affiliated groups.
- 5. Each affiliate will promote membership in CMC.
- 6. Each affiliate will make their membership and mailing lists available to CMC.
- 7. Each affiliate will contribute articles and news items to the publications of CMC.
- 8. Each affiliate will develop new leaders, workers and speakers who will eventually serve CMC.
